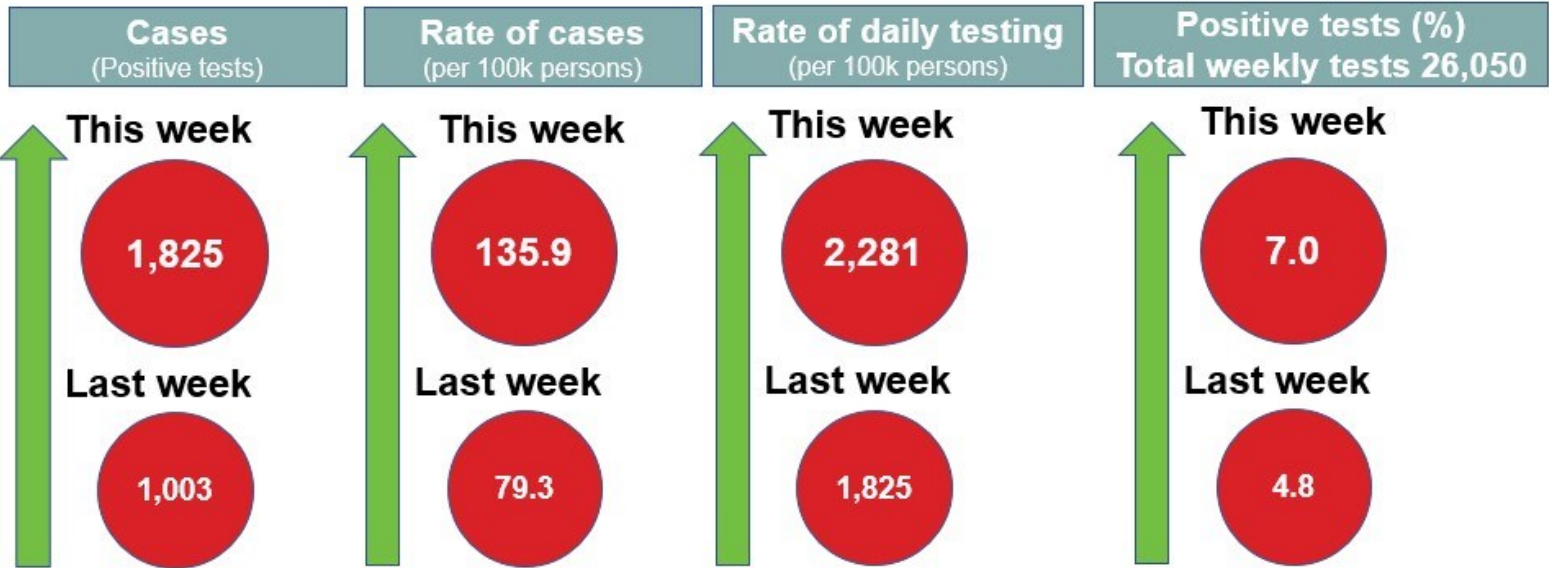

The rate of new cases in Birmingham continues to increase, although some of this is due to an increase in testing, there has also been an increase in the percentage of tests that are positive, so this reflects a real rise in the community.

The highest rate of new cases is in the 30-39yr age group, followed by 40-49yrs and 20-29yrs age groups and is lowest in the 0-9yrs and the 70-79yrs age groups. The case rate is highest in Asian ethnic communities.

Hospitalisations have risen over the last month and there has also been a small increase in people in intensive care, or supported by oxygen, due to Covid-19.

Most identified contacts of confirmed cases are household members and household visitors, and we continue to see spread primarily through social mixing in private households.
